**Authorization:** the MPA ESports Committee authorizes PlayVS to administer all games for the Fall and Spring seasons for MPA member schools.

**Team Rosters:** Teams are coed. Teams are comprised of a variety of team members depending on the game played.

**Equipment:** Equipment for each game varies.  
FIFA and Madden – Console only  
Super Smash Bros. Ultimate is played on Switch

**Hands-off Period:** Esports played under the MPA through PlayVS do not follow the MPA Sports Season Policy. Coaches are restricted from organizing play in the state titles until two weeks prior to the PlayVS preseason for registration, tryouts, and organization. The season would end with the MPA/PlayVS championship. Summer is open to all activity until the MPA two-week Hands-off Period prior to fall sports.

**Post Season:** The Maine Principals' Association post season will be scheduled with PlayVS.

The MPA/PlayVS will host an in-person State Championship for fall Rocket League, Mario Kart, and Super Smash Bros. Ultimate at Central Maine Community College in Auburn on Saturday, April 5, 2025.

**Awards:** The Maine Principals' Association will award a Champions plaque and a Runner-up plaque in each PlayVS league that has 20 or more schools participating or PlayVS sponsors a Maine State Championship with the MPA.

## **ESPORTS CLASSIFICATION**

For 2025-2026 all Maine schools will compete in one class per game.
